Christian Faure is Head of Unit in CINEA, the European Climate, Infrastructure and Environment Executive Agency. His Unit is in charge of implementing the Connecting Europe Facility – a key EU funding instrument for transport infrastructure- in several Member States, including Portugal.

Christian Faure is graduated from the French engineering school Ecole des Mines de Paris and obtained a master degree in Business Administration in the Spanish distant university (UNED).

He began his career in the French railways (SNCF) before joining the European Commission Directorate General for environment in 2000.

He became responsible for the European Rail Traffic Management System (ERTMS) program in 2005 in the Directorate General for environment.

After that, he was appointed deputy Head of Unit in the Directorate General in charge of maritime affairs and fisheries where he was leading the team implementing the European Maritime and Fisheries Funds in Western and South Europe. He is Head of Unit in the Executive Agency since 2015.
